
Download and Install

Go to <https://maps.cise.jmu.edu>, click the link for [ArcGIS & Esri Licensing](#), Agree to the Esri Terms of Service, log in using your JMU eID and password, and finally [Download ArcGIS Pro 3.5](#). As of ArcGIS version 3.0, you will also need the Microsoft .Net **Desktop Runtime**: <https://dotnet.microsoft.com/en-us/download/dotnet/8.0>.



Logging into ArcGIS Pro


When opening ArcGIS Pro for the first time, you will be prompted to log in. Choose the “Your ArcGIS organizations URL” button:



Next, provide the URL as simply “jmu” then click “Continue”:



If the URL has been provided correctly, you will see a button for “James Madison University”. Click that to proceed:



Finally, log into Okta like you would My Madison or Canvas:
