

Cise VirtualBox Appliance

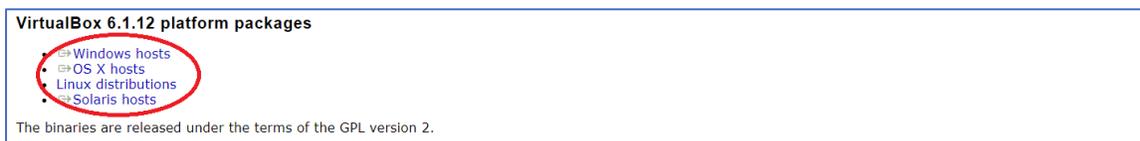

The Cise Student VirtualBox Appliance allows you to run Windows under macOS or Linux. It also includes:

- Office 365 Pro Plus with Visio Pro and Project Pro

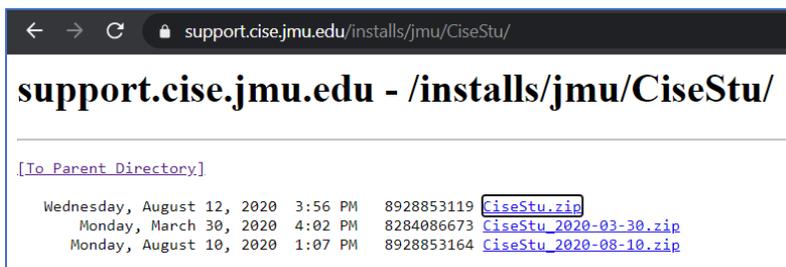
Download and Install VirtualBox

Go to <https://www.virtualbox.org/wiki/Downloads> and download the version of VirtualBox that matches your computer's OS:



Download and Unzip the Cise VirtualBox Appliance

Go to <https://support.cise.jmu.edu/installs/jmu/CiseStu/>, log in with your JMU eID and password, and download [CiseStu.zip](#) (8.3 GB):

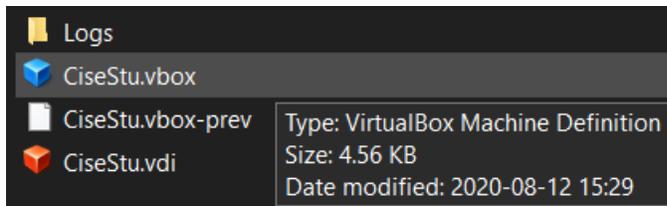

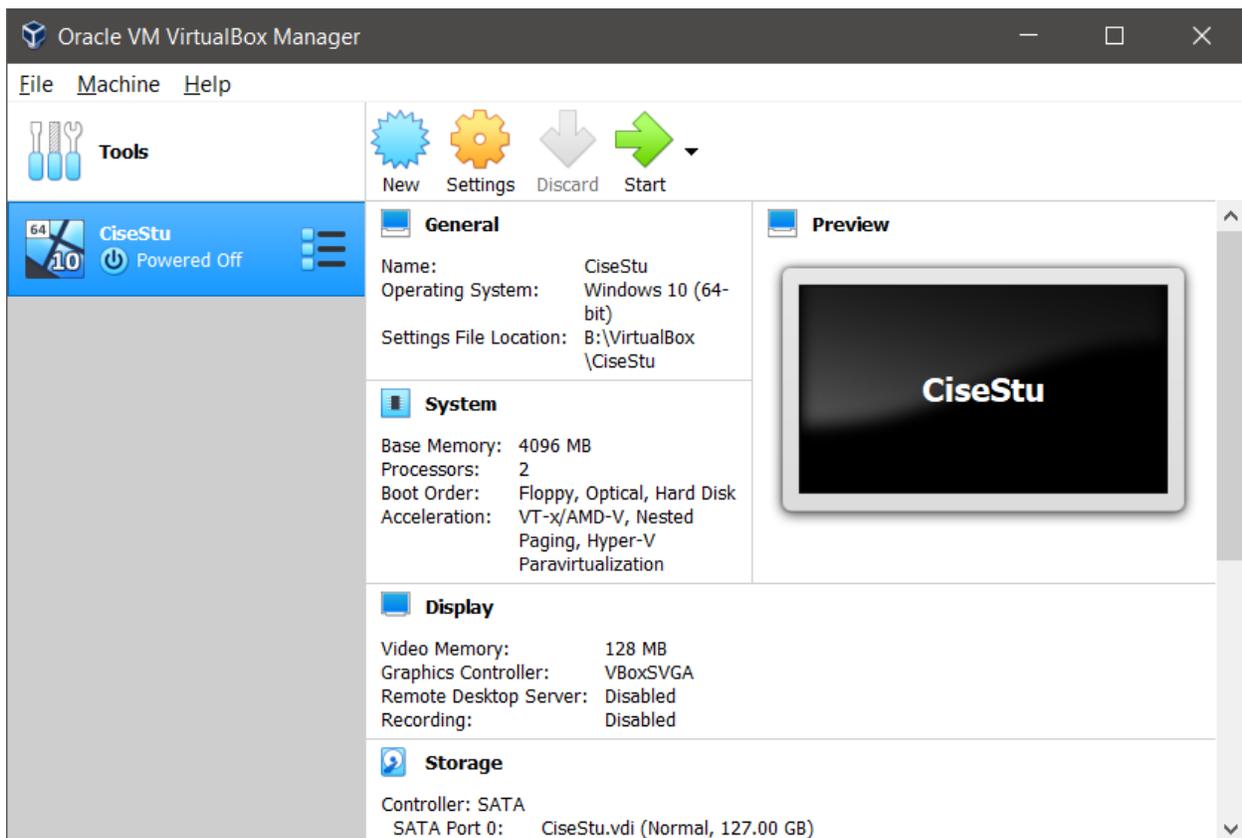
⚠ Once downloaded, open the zip file to extract it. The unzipped files will take an additional 18 GB of your hard disk, and may grow upon usage. Please delete the zip file to get 8 GB of your disk back.

Run the Cise VirtualBox Appliance

Within that extracted folder, double-click CiseStu.vbox. This will load the Cise Student Appliance within VirtualBox.



Within VirtualBox, make sure the CiseStu VM is selected, then click the green Start button:



This will launch the appliance, allowing you to use Windows and the installed applications. You may install additional applications within the appliance should you wish.

⚠ If you receive a “kernel driver not installed” error, you may need to [go into the System Preferences App to allow software from Oracle](#).
