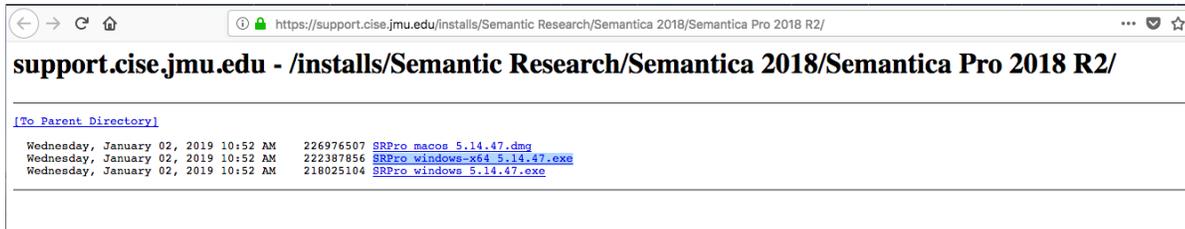


## Semantica Pro 2018 Installation Instructions

When prompted enter your *JMU eID* and *Password*



Most windows users should download and run the 64-bit installer:

[SRPro windows-x64 5.14.47.exe](#)

This application will install Semantica Pro from the internet.

NOTE → Mac users should download:

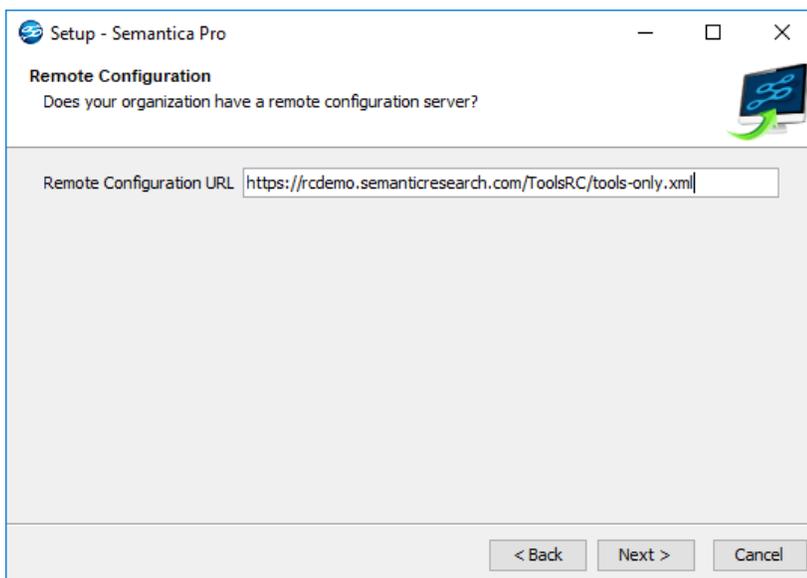
[SRPo macos 5.14.47.dmg](#)

You will need to mount this file and then run the installer.

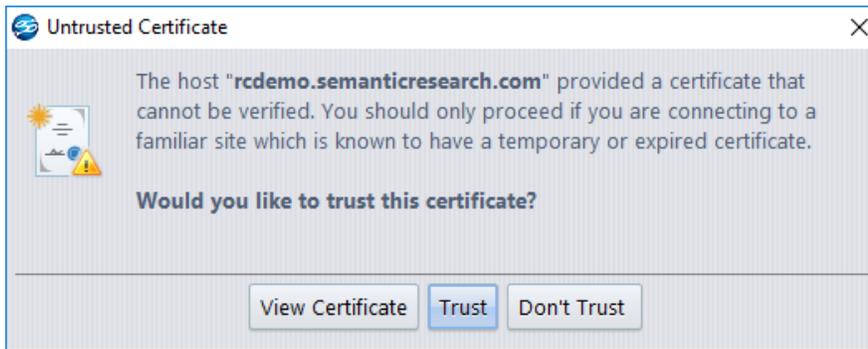
Accept all the default options.

When prompted for the Remote Configuration URL enter:

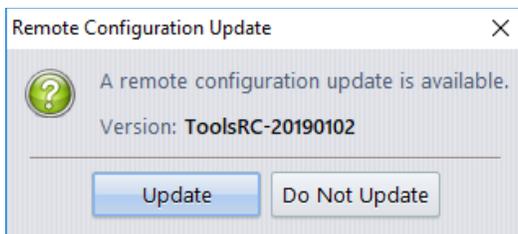
<https://rcdemo.semanticresearch.com/ToolsRC/tools-only.xml>



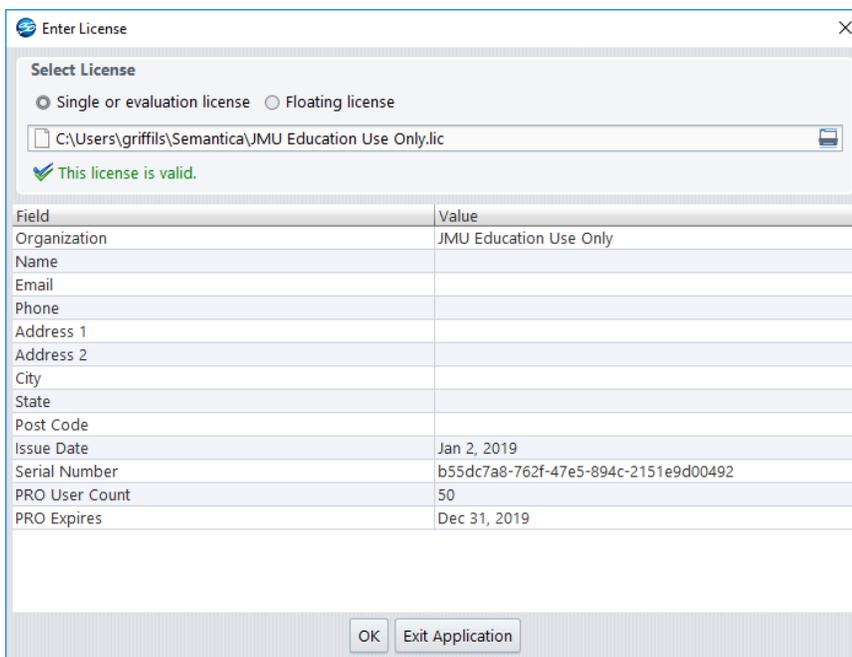
When you first launch the application, you may receive a warning message about an Untrusted Certificate. Select Trust.



When you first launch the application, you may receive a message similar to the image below to upgrade the software. Feel free to do so.



Lastly, you will be prompted to enter the location of the license file. You should have received a license file from your instructor (possibly via Canvas). Please download the file to a location of your choice and enter it in the box seen below (NOTE that I placed the file in my Semantica folder, you may have stored yours in a different location):



You should now be able to use the software!
